

Mrs. Anna Knebel.

Born Nov 14, 1842 Died Apr 25, '06.

The funeral of the late Mrs. Anna Knebel was held here Friday afternoon, first at the residence of Geo Homrighausen and then at the German Reformed church, conducted by Rev J Louk. Interment followed in the High German cemetery.

Anna Elizabeth Bender was born November 14, 1842, in Wunderthausen, Germany, and was married there October 17, 1862, to John Knebel. February 10, 1867, they immigrated to this country, and settled near this place. Some years ago Mr. Knebel preceded her to the better land. To them were born twelve children, of whom five sons and four daughters are now living. They are John, of Tipton, Edward, Charles, Fred and Henry, of near here, Mrs J N. Homrighausen, of Big Rock, Mrs of Inland, Mrs Broadway and Miss Caroline, who are at home.

Mrs Knebel was a good member of the German Reformed church, an excellent neighbor and steadfast friend, always ready to help those who were in need, and by all who knew her will she be sadly missed.
