On Friday afternoon, May 21, 1897, occurred the death of Miss Anna Elizabeth Fey, at the age of 56 years and 24 days.

She was born in Wunderthausen, Prussia, April 27, 1841, and has lived here since 1868. For many years she was a nurse in the home of John Rels and was regarded as one of the family, being generously remembered in the will of the elder Reis. Her life has been full of usefulness and many have been nursed through sickness, and assisted in times of trouble and bereavement by the ready hands and sympathetic heart, now cold in death. She leaves three brothers; George and Henry, living near here, and Phillip, living somewhere in the east.

The funeral occurred at the German Reformed church last Sunday morning, Rev. C. G. Zipf officiating, and the attendance was unusually large. The remains were laid to their eternal rest in the church cemetery northeast of town. Published May 26, 1897 in the Wheatland Gazette.

Her birth date is incorrect here. The German church records are clear that she was born in 1840
