John Heinrich Homenighausen, an elderly and successful farmer, and one of the early settlers of this county, died at his home, two and a half miles south of Wheatland, Thursday, June 15, 1893, at the age of 67 years.

The funeral services were conducted at the residence by Rev. C. G. Zipf, and the remains were interred in the private burying ground of the family at the homestead, Friday afternoon, June 16.

Deceased was a man much respected by his neighbors and beloved by his family; a true friend and upright citizen. Published in the Wheatland Gazette June 21, 1893.

His last name of "Homrighausen" was misspelled and no mention is made of his survivors. The burial, as noted, was on the family farm. The small cemetery is known to us now as the "Homrighausen Cemetery." He was born July 12, 1827.
