Notes on Maria Amalia Homrighausen

 MARIA AMALIA¹ HOMRIGHAUSEN was born on December 20, 1864 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1932 in Kaw, Jackson County, Missouri, United States of America. She married Johann Franz Knoche, son of Georg Ludwig Knoche and Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen, on August 05, 1884 in Miami, Kansas, USA. He was born on July 01, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He died in September 1920 in Paola, Miami, Kansas.

Notes for Maria Amalia Homrighausen: Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to America on the ship Köln out of Bremerhaven arriving in Baltimore April 10, 1881. Known as Amelia.

Notes for Johann Franz Knoche:

Known as John in America. He was recorded as the out-of-wedlock child of his mother in Schäfers Haus in Wunderthausen with no notation as to who the father was. Three years later his mother went to America with some others from Wunderthausen and eventually married Georg Ludwig Knoche from that party. While he may or may not have been the father of the child, John took the name Knoche. By his own report, he came to America in 1867 long after his mother. As of 1900 they were living with their children on the farm of his parents (close the George W. Homrighausen farm).

Johann Franz Knoche and Maria Amalia Homrighausen had the following children:

i. LOUIS FRANK² KNOCHE was born on July 01, 1885. He died on January 06, 1962.

Notes for Louis Frank Knoche: Apparently never married.

ii. KATHERINE KNOCHE was born on July 01, 1885. She died in 1960.

Notes for Katherine Knoche: Known as Katie. Apparently never married.

- iii. ANNA ELISABETH KNOCHE was born on September 09, 1886 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. She died on March 16, 1976 in Barton County, Kansas. She married August Wilhelm Fleske on June 12, 1918. He was born on March 23, 1885 in Germany. He died on November 10, 1964 in Larned, Pawnee, Kansas.
- iv. DENA B. KNOCHE was born on April 12, 1889. She died in December 1971.

Notes for Dena B. Knoche: Apparently never married.

v. JOHN GEORGE KNOCHE was born on September 28, 1891 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. He died on February 11, 1984 in Barton County, Kansas.
