

Elizabeth Broadway is Dead

Mrs. Elizabeth Broadway, of 503 West 17th St., Davenport, passed away Sunday at 12:30 p. m., at her home, after an illness of several months.

The deceased lady was born Oct. 15, 1864, in Germany, and for the past thirty years has lived in Davenport. She was married to William Broadway at Lone Tree in 1893. She was a member of St. Pauls church of Wheatland.

Surviving here are two sisters, Mrs. Harry Kinnan and Mrs. Caroline Meiers of Tipton; four brothers, John Knabel of Bettendorf, Edward and Fred Knabel of Big Rock, and Henry Knabel of Wheatland; and a number of nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at 1.30 p. m. today, Wednesday, in the McGinnis funeral home, with burial in St. Pauls cemetery. Wheatland
