1. **Elisabeth Caroline Knoche**, daughter of Johannes Knoche and Maria Amalia Knoche, was born on March 07, 1836 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Elisabeth Caroline Knoche:

Born in Bormanns house, Wunderthausen. Came to the US with family members on the ship Diana out of Bremen which landed in New Orleans on June 2, 1841. She was living with her unmarried uncle, Johann Philipp as of 1850 rather than with her mother who had remarried. I know nothing more about her.

2. **Johannes Knoche**, son of Georg Gabriel Knoche and Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen, was born on March 14, 1801 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 14, 1885 in Wunderthausen. He married **Maria Amalia Knoche** on May 17, 1835 in Wunderthausen.
3. **Maria Amalia Knoche**, daughter of Johannes Knoche and Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen, was born on February 01, 1810 in Wunderthausen. She died before 1860 in Jackson, Missouri.

Notes for Johannes Knoche:

Born in Bormanns house in Wunderthausen, and became the tenant/owner. The second marriage ended in divorce, and the mother apparently went to America with Caroline.

Notes for Maria Amalia Knoche:

Born in Beitzels house. The marriage with Johannes Knoche ended in divorce. Came to the US with family members and her to-be husband, Johann Georg Knoche on the ship Diana out of Bremen which landed in New Orleans on June 2, 1841. She is listed in the 1850 Census as 'Mary' but by 1860 she was dead.

4. **Georg Gabriel Knoche**, son of Johannes Knoche and Elisabeth Gertraud Pott, was born on August 30, 1773 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 17, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He married **Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen** on May 29, 1798 in Wunderthausen.
5. **Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen**, daughter of Johann Georg Homrighausen and Anna Elisabeth Knebel, was born on November 21, 1773 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 01, 1833 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Gabriel Knoche:

Born in and was the tenant in Bormann Haus.

Notes for Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen:

There is confusion in the church records about Elisabeth and her twin, Catherine. The death record refers to Catherine, the wife of Georg Gabriel Knoche. Yet baptismal records of the children consistently refer to Georg Gabriel and Elisabeth Gertraudt as the parents.

Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen and Georg Gabriel Knoche had the following children:

Notes for Johann Georg Fuchs:

Master joiner, born in Seimes house. Took over Lotzes house which from then on was known as Fuchs house.

She was born on February 01, 1810 in Wunderthausen. She died before 1860 in Jackson, Missouri. He married Anna Elisabeth Weller on February 21, 1830 in Wunderthausen. She was born in 1806 in Diedenshausen. She died on December 10, 1834 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Krohe on March 03, 1839 in Wunderthausen. She was born about 1813 in Wemlighausen. She died on January 30, 1856.
  - iv. Johann Georg Knoche was born on January 13, 1805 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 07, 1859 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Amalia Strackbein on July 26, 1840 in Wunderthausen. She was born on September 29, 1814 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 17, 1880 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Johann Georg Knoche:  
Brückeweimers.

Notes for Maria Amalia Strackbein:  
Born in Schäfers house, Wunderthausen. Arrived in New York on the ship S. S. Donau out of Bremen on November 25, 1871. She had been widowed for more than ten years. Several other passengers were from Wunderthausen including her daughter Florentine. I do not know where she lived but it was almost certainly with one or more of her children.

- v. Georg Ludwig Knoche was born on October 10, 1809 in Wunderthausen. He died in Probably in America. He married Maria Magdalena Schneider. She was born on August 30, 1812 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 30, 1845 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Knoche:  
Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen. He traveled with some relatives to the port of New Orleans on the ship Diana in 1841. It is most likely that he joined relatives in the Kansas City area but I have no other information. Daughter Elisabeth used the family name of Knoche even though the parents were not married.

6. **Johannes Knoche**, son of Johannes Knoche and Elisabeth Gertraud Pott, was born on November 10, 1778 in Wunderthausen. He died about 1844 in Hallenberg. He married **Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen** on May 29, 1798 in Wunderthausen.
7. **Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen**, daughter of Johann Georg Homrighausen and Anna Elisabeth Knebel, was born on January 01, 1781 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 05, 1838 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Knoche:  
Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen but became the tenant in Beitzels Haus through marriage. He was prepared to go to America in 1841 but changed his mind at that time. Legal correspondence says that he was by then living in neighboring Hallenberg. According to American family lore, he was killed in an accident at the age of 65. The year 1844 is a best guess given his November birthday.

Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen and Johannes Knoche had the following children:

- i. Georg Gabriel Knoche was born on June 03, 1801 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 11, 1841 in Bremen.

Notes for Georg Gabriel Knoche:  
Born in Beitzels Haus in Wunderthausen. He died from a fall from a wagon either in or on the way to Bremen from whence much of the family intended to travel to America.

- ii. Johannes Knoche was born on December 16, 1803 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 20, 1832 in Wunderthausen.

- iii. Georg Ludwig Knoche was born on January 09, 1807 in Wunderthausen. He died before 1870 in Prob. Jackson County, MO.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Knoche:

Born in Beitzels house in Wunderthausen. He came to America around 1835 though returned to Germany for a while around 1841. As far as I know he never married but lived with his brother Johann Philipp's family.

3. iv. Maria Amalia Knoche was born on February 01, 1810 in Wunderthausen. She died before 1860 in Jackson, Missouri. She married Johannes Knoche on May 17, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He was born on March 14, 1801 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 14, 1885 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Knoche about 1841. He was born on June 05, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died after 1860 in Jackson, Missouri.
- v. Johann Philipp Knoche was born on April 10, 1813 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 29, 1888 in Missouri. He married Anna Elisabeth Knoche in 1863 in Missouri. She was born on December 04, 1842 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 12, 1931 in Kansas City, Wyandotte, Kansas (Elmwood Cemetery, Jackson County). He married Elisabeth Florentine Knoche on December 16, 1858 in Missouri. She was born on September 22, 1831 in Wunderthausen. She died on October 02, 1861 in Jackson County, Missouri.

Notes for Johann Philipp Knoche:

He was born in Beitzels Haus in Wunderthausen and came to Baltimore on the ship "Palmer" arriving on July 1, 1834.

According to a petition filed in 1840, Knoche first came to the U.S. in 1834, lived in Baltimore, and was naturalized March 9, 1840. He returned to Wittgenstein in 1840 to assist his father in coming to America, but was informed by the Prussian authorities that he was obliged to military service insofar as he had left Germany originally without permission. Through a lawyer, he asked the American government if he was not protected as an American citizen? The reply from an official named Henry Wheaton was that they could not help him. "Having returned to the country of your birth, your native domicile and national character revert (so long as you remain in the Prussian dominions), and you are bound in all respects to obey the laws exactly as if you had never emigrated." This would not have been the only case of its type, but international law on citizenship became clearer eventually. U.S. law then and now defines citizenship on the basis of where one was born; this was the exception at the time. More common historically, citizenship was defined by "blood": one inherited the nationality of one's father.

Despite this legal setback, the Knoche family including Johann Philipp did come to America. He and two brothers came to the US on the ship Everhard out of Bremen, landing in Baltimore on May 25, 1841. He lived in the Kaw Township, Jackson County, Missouri, and died there. By the standards of the time he became quite wealthy. The 1860 census included estimates of the value of each household head's land (if any) and personal estate. John's numbers were \$14,300 and \$6,000 respectively. This would place him in the top 20% or so in his township. A plat map from 1877 shows him in possession of almost a section (640) acres of land bordered by the Missouri River

From Biographical Sketches of Jackson County

The Doctor's [that is, the son John Phillip] parents were John P. and Florendina Knoche, and their family numbered only 2 children, 1 of whom died in infancy. The father was a farmer by occupation, and on emigrating to the new world took up his residence in Baltimore, in 1834, being employed there in John Wetter's distillery for 6 years. In 1839 he returned to Germany, and on again coming to the United States was accompanied by 3 brothers. They settled in Jackson county, Missouri, near Kansas City, in 1840. It was then known as West Landing. There were not near them a half-dozen houses; there was a grocery, etc. The country was wild and sparsely settled. He intended to establish a distillery, and had the building

erected and a part of the machinery in when the flood of 1844 swept all away. John P. Knoche then removed to Santa Fe, Missouri, where he purchased and entered a large tract of land, engaging there in raising cattle for the Santa Fe traders. In this way he accumulated considerable wealth, but after a time disease broke out among the cattle in this section of the country, and he lost nearly all his stock, while his house and barns were destroyed by fire. Thus misfortune seemed to fall thick and fast around him. He was a man of much purpose, however, and returned to his farm in Jackson county, near Kansas City, but retained the ownership of his farm near Santa Fe, and operated both until after the war broke out. At that time he joined the home guards. His land lay between the territory occupied by Jennison's Kansas "Redlegs" and Price's raiders, who stole all his corn, hogs and hay. His wife was also frightened to death in 1861 by some of Jennison's troops! She was a member of the Lutheran church, a faithful helpmeet to her husband and a loving mother. In 1863 Mr. Knoche was again married, his second union being with Annie E. Knoche, a sister of his first wife. They had 9 children - 4 sons and 5 daughters, of whom the following-named are yet living: John H., Louis H., Joseph and Rosa A. The father died August 29, 1887, in his 75th year, but his 2nd wife is still living, on the old homestead.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. She came to America on the ship 'Carl' landing in New Orleans out of Bremen on October 13, 1858. She had additional children we do not know of. Some records shown a Daniel (John) as a son but this cannot be correct.

Notes for Elisabeth Florentine Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Arrived October 20, 1854 in New Orleans on the ship "Auguste" out of Bremen.

- vi. Ludwig Heinrich Knoche was born on January 17, 1817 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 29, 1817 in Wunderthausen.
- vii. Johann Heinrich Knoche was born on February 26, 1819 in Wunderthausen. He died in Prob. America.

Notes for Johann Heinrich Knoche:

Born in Beitzels Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to the US on the ship Everhard out of Bremen, landing in Baltimore on May 25, 1841. Two of his brothers were also aboard. It was indicated that he was bound for Missouri. I have found no further trace of him in America.

- viii. Johannes Knoche was born on May 09, 1823 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 17, 1898 in Jackson, Missouri (Elmwood Cemetery, Jackson County).

Notes for Johannes Knoche:

Born in Beitzels Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to the US on the ship Everhard out of Bremen, landing in Baltimore on May 25, 1841. Two of his brothers were also aboard. His brief obituary implies that he never married and that he lived with a brother in Jackson County. He is probably in the household of Johann Philipp as of 1860. A Find-A-Grave record shows him married to Eufrazia Noland but that is not correct. She was married to a younger, American-born John Knoche who I have not precisely identified.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen:

Born in Seimes house. Became the tenant through marriage in Leyeschneiders. First known tenant in the house known as Unter der Laye. His family of origin is not certain.

Notes for Anna Catharina Boshoff:

She was born in the house known variously as Gertrudens, Unter der Leye, and Leienschneiders. There is no record of her birth, but several generations of Boßhof (Booßhoff) are recorded there in other records. As of 1650, the house itself lay between Wunderthausen and Diedenshausen. When it was moved into Wunderthausen is not known.

Anna Catharina Boshoff and Johann Georg Homrighausen had the following children:
