Notes on Catharine Lauber

1. **CATHARINE**¹ **LAUBER** was born on March 18, 1841 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1876 in Prairie du Long, Monroe, Illinois. She married August Dickel, son of Christian Wilhelm Dickel and Anna Elisabeth Sonneborn, on February 03, 1867. He was born on August 07, 1839 in Rospe, Oberbergischer Kreis, North Rhine-Westphalia,. He died on August 16, 1869 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Catharine Lauber:

Born in Hohmanns Haus in Wunderthausen. She came to America with her daughters Catherine and Luise. The "Apollo" arrived in New York out of Bremen on May 31, 1875. Her sister, Maria, had come to America a few years before as did two uncles. With her husband presumably deceased and only son dead as a boy, she had little to lose by going to America with the girls. I can find no further trace of any of them.

Notes for August Dickel:

He presumably died some time between 1869 and 1875. I can find no records however. They lived in her family home of "Hohmanns" although he is described as being a forester in Petersgrund.

August Dickel and Catharine Lauber had the following children:

- i. AUGUST² DICKEL was born on August 27, 1864 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 25, 1869 in Wunderthausen.
