Died.

MRS. AMELIA MOERCHEN-SCHNEI-DER, wife of the late Ludwig II. Schneider, died at her home Thursday, March 15, 1894, at the uge of 85 years and 6 days.

Deceased was born in Wunderthausen, Prussia, March 9, 1809. In 1857 she crossed the ocean and came to this vicinity, where she remained. She was a woman who was universally respected by her friends and neighbors and greatly beloved by her husband and children. She leaves four sons; Phillip, Ludwig, Henry and George, to mourn her departure.

The funeral services were held Friday at the German Reformed church, and the remains of one of the oldest settlers of this part of Iowa were laid in their last resting place at the German Reform cemetery in the presence of relatives and many sorrowing friends.
