Ludwig Carl Riedesel Was born January the 7th, 1840, in Wunderhausen, Germany. He was baptized and confirmed and reared in a Christian home. At the age of 26 he was united in marriage to Miss Katherine Peter, from Diensthaus and emigrated into America the year following After they had rented farms in the vicinity of Wheatland for several years they bought the so called "Cambridge" farm where they have lived ever since. As a German soldier. Mr Riedesel was a member of the Kreiger-Verein of Lowden. Mrs. Katherme Riedesel and four children preceded him in death. He leaves to mourn his death, six sons, lour daughters, one brother and one sister of Rochester New York, 32 grand children and a large number ot relatives and friends. Riedesel breathed his last at the fourth hour of the New Year at the age of almost 70 years 7 days lacking May he rest in peace "I fa'll asleep in Jesus wounds, . There pardoned for my sms abounds, Yea, Jesus blood and righteousness, My jewels are, my glorious dress; Wherem before my God I'll stand,

When I shall reach the heavuly land.
