

Ancestors of Philippine Riedesel

Generation 1

1. **Philippine Riedesel**, daughter of Johann Henrich Riedesel and Johanna Henriette Marie Luise Gäkler, was born on February 02, 1818 in Berleburg.

Notes for Philippine Riedesel:

We know nothing about this child other than that she was approved to emigrate with her parents in 1819. We can only assume that how ever much life she had was led in the Philadelphia area.

Generation 2

2. **Johann Henrich Riedesel**, son of Johann Georg Riedesel and Elisabeth Belz, was born on June 14, 1772 in Berleburg. He died in Prob Philadelphia. He married **Johanna Henriette Marie Luise Gäkler** on February 18, 1817 in Berleburg.
3. **Johanna Henriette Marie Luise Gäkler**, daughter of Johann Heinrich Gäkler and Marie Katherine Herwig, was born on February 11, 1784 in Schwarzenau. She died in May 1840 in Philadelphia, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (Buried 14 May 1840).

Notes for Johann Henrich Riedesel:

"Henrich" was a typical spelling at the time.

He was a great-grandson of the master builder Mannus Riedesel. His father, Johann Georg, had married Elisabeth Belz of Berleburg. This may have been a step up socially, but the Riedesels of his line in the hamlet of Melbach may also have maintained a closer connection to the ruling Sayn-Wittgensteins than their Riedesel kin in other villages. I only know of two children of this marriage, with both sons emigrating to Philadelphia.

German records show him as young man going to Rondorf (near Wuppertal) in 1791 then going to Holland in 1792. These were way stations for many America-bound religious dissenters. The next documented mention is of his marriage to Johanna Henriette Marie Luise Gäkler on February 18, 1817 back in Berleburg. She was from the village of Schwarzenau which was long a home to religious sectarians. Their daughter Philippine's birth in 1818 is recorded in Berleburg.

The princely archives in Berleburg include this document:

Der Johann Henr. Riedesel zu Berleburg hat die Emigrations Urkunde für sich, seine Frau und Tochter und für seinen Bruder Joh. Ludwig heute in Empfang genommen. Ich benachrichtige Sie hiervon.

(That is: Today, Johann Henr. Riedesel of Berleburg received emigration documents for himself, his wife and daughter, and for his brother Johann Ludwig. May 17, 1819)

The next we hear of Johann Henrich and his brother is as passengers on the brig Osgood out of Amsterdam that landed in Philadelphia on September 20, 1819. With Johann Heinrich was a wife Louise and a child.

Records of a church in Philadelphia show the baptism of a Johannes Riedesel, son of "Dokt. Johann Hein. Riedesel" and his wife, Marie Louise. The child was born January 3, 1820, and was baptised on March 16, 1820. The "doctor" title was an honorific bestowed in some of the German religious sects to especially honored members. He almost certainly did not practice as a physician.

Louise died in May 1840 at about 55 years of age and is buried in the Salems Cemetery.

Other Wittgensteiners belonged to this church. At one point it was the "United High German

Evangelical Calvinist Reformed Church. Later it was simply the "Salem German Reformed Church."

I am 95% certain that the boy Johannes born in 1820 was the John B. Riedesel who was Missing in Action after the Battle of Chancellorsville in 1863. The latter left progeny, with the Riedesel name surviving in Philadelphia until 1963.

Notes for Johanna Henriette Marie Luise Gäkler:

Known as (Marie) Luise. We believe her family lived in the village of Schwarzenau though the baptism is recorded in the parish church of Elsoff. That she had four personal names is clear from the church records. In the emigration record and American church records she is referred to as Marie Luise or just Luise (or Louise or Luisa).

The family name was Gäkler. You will see her or even her father referred to as "Gäklerin" but this is misleading. It was an old German convention to refer to an unmarried woman with -in added to her family name. It was a kind of diminutive. I doubt that this convention occurred in everyday speech, but you do see it in official records. Don't be misled.

Johanna Henriette Marie Luise Gäkler and Johann Henrich Riedesel had the following children:

Notes for Johannes Riedesel:

All evidence suggests that this Johannes Riedesel is identical with the John B. Riedesel whose later life and death are well-documented. It is likely that he is the John Redasel enumerated in the 1850 Census in Philadelphia. He was a cabinet maker living (singly) in a large household of unrelated persons--possibly a boarding house. His age is given as 31, which is close.

A John Riedesel starts to show up in 1850s city directories as a maker of "trimmings", which would also be a kind of woodworker. A John Riedesel was an undertaker in 1860 (who would need wooden coffins). I have yet to find John and/or his two sons in the 1860 Census. His ex-wife was back living with her parents. The marriage ended in divorce in 1859, but the details are under permanent seal.

John B. Riedesel enlisted in the 28th Pennsylvania Infantry Regiment in 1861, and was declared missing in action during the Battle of Chancellorsville (May, 1863). No age can be found in the army pension records and there is no enlistment record, but when the company was mustered out at the end of the war, a notation was made of "age 40." That is not precisely correct for Johannes, but close enough.

His former father-in-law, Jesse Ott, spent a couple of years collecting the paperwork necessary to receive a pension for John's two minor children.

Notes for Amanda Lavinia Ott:

She married a William Ruckstool in 1860, after the divorce. It appears that she married a third time, to a Phillips. When her mother died in 1894, the probate records refer to "Amanda L. Phillips" of Clemmington, NJ, as one of the heirs. If she is the Amanda (Mrs. Thomas) Phillips of Camden, NJ, in 1900, then she bore a total of 12 children. Five were living in 1900.

Generation 3

4. **Johann Georg Riedesel**, son of Johannes Riedesel and Anna Catharina Schuppener, was born on June 21, 1728 in Melbach. He died on February 19, 1808 in Berleburg. He married **Elisabeth Belz** on June 17, 1771 in Berleburg.

Notes for Johann Ludwig Riedesel:

I have found no documentation for him after his arrival in America.

He arrived on the brig Osgood in Philadelphia on September 20, 1819. It had sailed from Amsterdam.

Notes for Johann Franz Spies:
Born in and tenant in Schreiners Haus, Diedenshausen. According to local tradition, he personally carried a complaint from the peasants of Diedenshausen to the German Emperor in Vienna about the heavy burden of taxation and other duties imposed by the Count. Nothing was ever done about it.

Notes for Johann Mannus Riedesel:

Tenant in Herjes Haus at Melbach/Balde. He was known as Mannus Riedesel, and is still regarded as a master builder. When and where he learned his craft is not known, but he was in demand throughout Wittgenstein and neighboring areas such as Siegen. Ten structures he built are known to exist today though there were many others. The most spectacular is the "Ludwigsburg" in the town of Berleburg. It was built for a brother of Graf Casimir between 1707-1709. Another was the forester's lodge at the site of the defunct village of Dambach; it is now a Pension. The well-known chapel/school in Sassenhausen was originally built just as a church, but was later modified to accommodate a (small) school room. They are gems of Fachwerk (half-timbered) construction, often with ornately carved corner posts, inscriptions, and other decorations.

Notes for Hederich Riedesel:

He is the earliest verifiable ancestor of all the Riedesels of Wittgenstein and of almost all American Riedesels. His name is sometimes rendered as Heyrich or Henrich, but local experts affirm that it was not "Heinrich." He was the tenant in the house called "Herjes" in the small hamlet of Melbach. He served for several years as a coachman to the Count in Berleburg during the 30 Years War (1618-1648) and documents say that his house stood empty for five years. He had returned by 1642. While he was a commoner subject to the Count, various signs suggest that the family was of somewhat higher status than most. It is not certain that his father "Heyrich Riedesel" preceded him at Herjes, but it is very likely.
