1. **GEORG HERMANN**¹ **WETTER** was born on October 26, 1798 in Wunderthausen. He married Eliza Ann Furlong on November 01, 1827. She was born on December 11, 1806. She died on October 01, 1868.

Notes for Georg Hermann Wetter:

Born in Petersgrund near Wunderthausen. Heinrich Imhof gives 1818 as the year he went to America. A George Herman was naturalized in 1818; the record says he was 25 which is off by a couple of years. It is not clear how many children they had. There were seven as of the 1840 Census (which does not show names). Six children are living in the "Whetter" household in 1860, but three were born after 1840. At least ten is a reasonable guess.

He was not the George Wetter who died in 1872 per someone's Sons of the American Revolution application.

Notes for George R. Wetter:

He enlisted in the First Light Artillery of the Maryland Volunteers. on September 18, 1861. I have not been able to identify the action in which he died (or if he died of disease, which accounted for more of the casualties of his unit.

- ii. JOHN H. WETTER was born about 1834 in Baltimore.
- iii. EDWIN WETTER was born about 1839 in Baltimore.
- iv. LOUIS/LUDWIG EVERSON WETTER was born on August 11, 1841 in Maryland. He died on December 24, 1900. He married Emma J. Parrish on May 01, 1873. She was born on September 07, 1847. She died on August 05, 1887.
- v. RICHARD/REINHARDT WETTER was born about 1846 in Baltimore. He died on February 10, 1908 in Sykesville, Carroll, Maryland.
- vi. EMMA WETTER was born about 1848 in Baltimore.
